What you need to do...

Step 1: Forms

Numbers are limited, with a strict 'first come, first served' policy – so you better get your application in early! Please fill in ALL details on both the '**Application Form**' and the '**Participant Information Form**' and send them both to:

Step 2: Payment

Please note payment is non-refundable, except in the event that the camp has sold out and payment will be immediately returned.

Step 3: Confirmation

When we receive your payment we will send out a confirmation text. If a week has passed since you mailed your application AND sent your payment and you have not received this text, please contact Zoe (details below).

Step 4: Prepare

Pack your things! These should include:

- **A packed lunch for the bus ride to camp on the first day**
- Three days worth of clothes; warm and cold
- Sleeping bag, pillow and sheet
- Bathers, towel, toiletries
- **COSTUMES** (we loooooove costumes, bring one for each night on the d-floor!!)
- All your meals are provided, but feel free to bring any snacks to get you through the day!

Please note that we do not allow any illegal drugs or substances on camp. If any of these are found they will be confiscated and you will be sent straight home.

All alcohol will be provided by the SSS. BYO is strictly prohibited, and any alcohol found will be confiscated.

Step 5: Arrive & Enjoy

Get to Uni at **9.30am** on Friday 15th February – **don't forget your packed lunch**. The best way to find us is to get yourself to the **Lincoln Square** tram terminus on Swanston St and then follow the chalk arrows to **Lincoln Square** (South of Grattan Street, in front of the Law Building).

Step 6: Return

Buses will return to Melbourne Uni on Sunday 17th by 5pm, but stick around afterwards for kick-ons at the local pub!
